7. Confidence skills

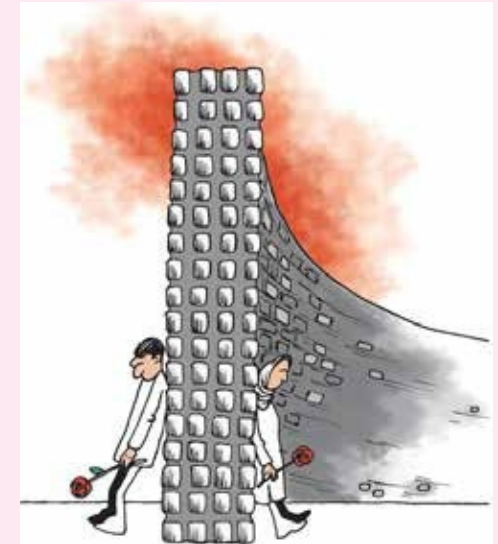
